## **Minutes of the Saturday October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022 club meeting.**

Our President - Travis Moyer called our third club meeting of the year to order at 12:00 PM. Eighteen club members were in attendance.

### **Finances:**

- Club Treasurer - Rich Collemacine provided the financial business report. Hard copies of the report were provided to all club members in attendance. The report recapped our income and operating expenses and highlighted income and expenses since our summer meeting. The finances were approved as presented. ### **Field Maintenance:**

- Ralph has installed new metal spectator signs onto the fences.
- We plan to roll next spring with a large roller rented from ORE.
- We need to build a water collection system on the roof of the new container to fill the water tank that will be used for pressure washing the mover.
- We need to move the breaker panel to the inside the new container.
- We need to sort and move the items that are outside of the old container to inside of the old container.

### **Turnpike Construction:**

- Improvements to access road is at status quo until the surrounding construction has been completed.
- A new wider gate is supposed to be installed at some point in the future to replace the previous gate that was too small to accommodate farming equipment.
- Our entrance sign has been relocated to the site of our new access road. Big thanks go out to Ralph; Brandon and Travis for their considerable efforts with digging it out, along with the large concrete base that it was attached to.

### **2023 Events:**

- **Giant Scale Event:**

- The Giant Scale event will take place on August 26th – 27th, 2023.
- This event has been moved back to the last weekend in August due to a conflict between GAAM model fly and Chenango Bridge giant scale event earlier in the month.
- The food vender will be Travelin Hot Dogs; [Formerly Big Guy’s Hot Dogs under new ownership].
- Two extra porta potties and a wash station will be ordered.
- Event proceeds will again be donated to local charities but the club members in attendance voted to change the donation disbursements. Our flying field is located within Milford Township and because of this for the past two years we have given the Milford Fire Co. a \$500.00 donation. Due to the BCSPCA’s less than enthusiastic engagement at our events the consensus determined that they would receive \$250.00 for each event with the remaining proceeds split between Trumbauersville Fire Co. and Milford Fire Co.

- **Quakertown Jet Jam:**

- The Quakertown Jet Jam event will take place Sept 29th – Oct 1st, 2023.
- The food vender will be Travelin Hot Dogs.
- Two extra porta potties with a Saturday night clean-out and a wash station will be ordered.
- Event proceeds and disbursement for this event will be the same as the Giant Scale 2023 event.
